City Ordinance Sec. 13-76. - Debris from construction, demolition, alterations or repair—Required.

(a) Every person engaging in the business of, or being hired for the purpose of, constructing, demolishing, remodeling, repairing, roofing, or altering, any building or other structure within the corporate limits of the city or within the police jurisdiction shall, upon completion of the job or construction project, remove any debris, concrete, lumber, roofing material, or any other waste material resulting from such activity, to the lawful disposal area; and, (b) Shall provide on-site receptacles for litter as defined hereinabove, and ensure that litter is properly placed in such containers, to prevent scattering of such litter by wind or rain if such litter is not otherwise properly disposed of on a daily basis . Whenever it is not feasible to place the onsite receptacle within the construction site, an onsite receptacle may be placed in the street or other right-of-way pursuant to a right-of-way permit issued by the Director of the Department of Transportation or his/her designee (Director), pursuant to guidelines set by the Director, who shall determine the permit conditions for each request including but not limited to liability insurance, permit expiration, safety requirements and waiver of liability. There shall be a permit application fee as set by the Director with the approval of the Mayor. (c) It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit such waste material, or litter on the public streets or public areas of the city and leave the same for pick-up and removal by the city. (d) It shall be unlawful for any person to place or allow to remain an onsite receptacle in the street or right-of-way without a valid permit.
